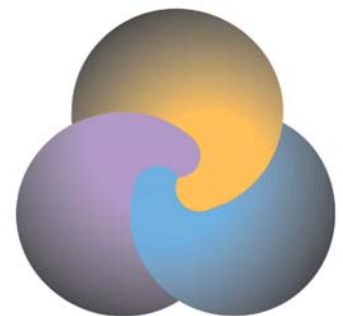
Appointments for most general dental services are available within three weeks.

<i>Restorative (crowns, inlays, onlays)</i>	\$75 copayment after \$10 office visit copayment (\$50/\$80/\$125 charge for noble/high noble metal/ upgraded, specialized porcelain may apply)
<i>Prosthodontics (bridges, dentures, partials)</i>	Dentures & Partials—\$125 copayment after \$10 office visit copayment (\$50/\$80/\$125 charge for noble/high noble metal/ upgraded, specialized porcelain may apply) Bridges—\$75 copayment after \$10 office visit copayment (\$50/\$80/\$125 charge for noble/high noble metal/ upgraded, specialized porcelain may apply)
<i>Periodontics (scaling, root planing)</i>	\$25 after \$10 office visit copayment
<i>Oral surgery (extractions)</i>	Covered 100% after \$10 office visit copayment
<i>Orthodontia</i>	For children, \$1,000 copayment For adults, \$1,800
<i>TMJ coverage</i>	\$1,000 annual maximum \$5,000 lifetime maximum
<i>Dentist choice</i>	All services must be provided by a Dental Health Services participating network general dentist 20% coinsurance for all pre-authorized covered specialty services (except orthodontics)
